



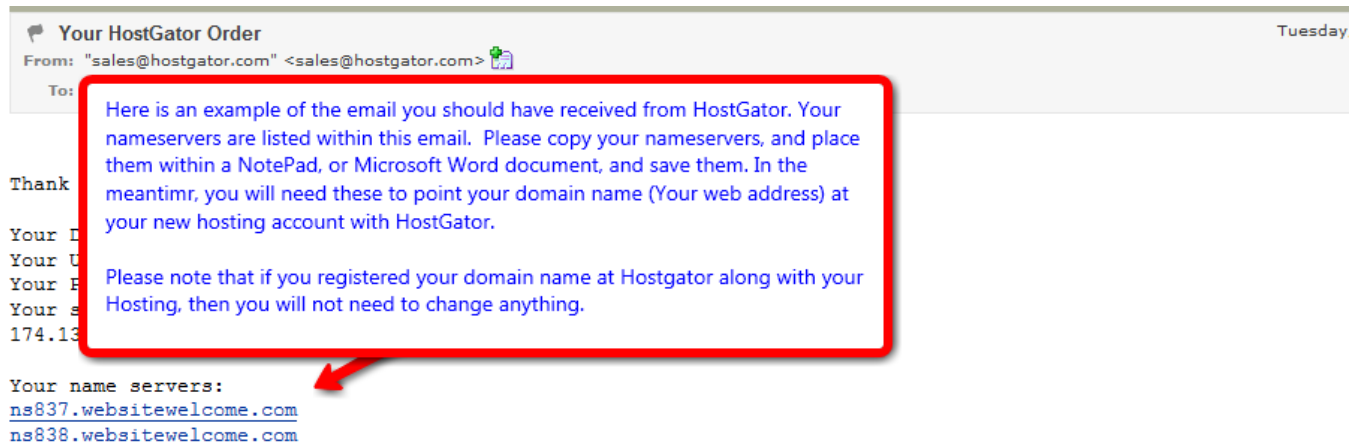
## How To Change Your Name servers”

**Who should do this? – Those who have domain names registered at GoDaddy**

The video provided will show you exactly what to do to point your new domain name (*Your web address*) at your new HostGator hosting account. Think of name-servers as a web address for GoDaddy – They need to know who is hosting your website, and you’re about to tell them making the change.

The screenshot below shows you a sample of what your email from HostGator should look like, and demonstrates what a name-server looks like. Within your welcome email, you should have received 2 name servers. Please watch or re-watch the video to see what you should do once you’ve located your name servers.

### *Sample Email:*



Once you’ve made the change within the system, you should give GoDaddy about 1 – 2 hours before the update will take place. Usually you’re told to wait 24 hours, but I’ve never had to wait more than 1 – 2 hours. Get started now so that you have enough time for the change to take effect prior to training.
